## Abstract

The purpose of this study was to find out training need assessment in teaching and learning of instructors in the Faculty of Nursing Chiang Mai University. The subjects were 118 instructors. Questionairs were constructed as a gathering data. The data were treated using a percentage and mean.

It was found that: (1) The most usage basic knowledge of these instructors was the state of behavioral objectives, Educational technology development and motivation techniques were needed for training. (2) Lecture and case study method were the most needed while problem-solving were high needed for training. (3) The most popular media for teaching were overhead projectors and slides while computer assisted instruction productions were needed for training. (4) The instructors were not comprehended in educational measurement and evaluation. They also needed this topic for training especially for the new comers instructors in every year.
