

Anurat Pongpianchob 2011: Students' Satisfaction on Instruction Business Work in Work – Oriented Experience and Technology of Mathayomsuksa 3 at Kasetsart University Laboratory School Center for Educational Research and Development. Master of Education (Business Education), Major Field: Business Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Chana Wannoon, M.Sc. 124 pages.

The purposes of the research were to investigate students' satisfaction on instruction Business Work in Work – Oriented Experience and Technology of Mathayomsuksa 3 at Kasetsart University Laboratory School Center for Educational Research and Development in 5 aspects: subject matter, teaching methods, instructors, teaching media and evaluation, and to compare the satisfaction of those aspects classified by sex and grade point average. The instrument was an questionnaire to collect data from 250 population students. The results were as follows: The satisfaction of the students in overall aspects were at high level. For the aspects of subject matter, teaching methods, instructors, teaching media and evaluation, the satisfaction of the students were at high level.

The hypothesis testing showed as follows: The students in different gender and different grade point average were no statistically significant at the .05 level.
