237 cases including 119 male and 118 female. Five

The Reliability of structured interview in 0.82.

departments of the study are Surgery, Medicine, Accidental & Emergency, Eye Ear Nose & Throat (EENT), and Chemical

Therapy & Rehabilitation.

This research was disigned to study In patient's perception of nursing care in four needs: 1) The physiological needs, 2) The safety needs, 3) The love & belonging needs, and 4) The need for self esteem. Chi-square, 7-test, and Fisher exact probability test used for data

Z-test, and Fisher exact probability test used for data analysis. The result of this study showed: The proporsion of in patient's perception of nursing care in physiological needs and safety needs, but no significant differences for the other needs. (P < 0.05)

For each department there were significant

For each department there were significant differences in the proportion of nursing care for 1) physiological needs, 2) safety needs, and 3) love & belonging needs, but no significant differences for self esteem needs. (P < 0.05)
