ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were

1. To Study In-patient's perception of nursing care
2. To Study nursing care's activity according to patient's need.

The purposes of this research were to test two hypotheses:

1. There will be significant differences of male & female's perception to nursing care.

2. There is difference of patients' perception in each department of Srinagarind hospital.

The Reliability of structured interview in 0.82.

The sample were patients admitted in Srinagarind hospital: 237 cases including 119 male and 118 female. Five departments of the study are Surgery, Medicine, Accidental & Emergency, Eye Ear Nose & Throat (EENT), and Chemical Therapy & Rehabilitation.

This research was designed to study In patient's perception of nursing care in four needs : 1) The physiological needs, 2) The safety needs, 3) The love & belonging needs, and 4) The need for self esteem. Chi-square, Z-test, and Fisher exact probability test used for data analysis. The result of this study showed : The proporsion of in patient's perception of nursing care in physiological needs and safety needs, but no significant differences for the other needs. ($P < 0.05$)

For each department there were significant differences in the proportion of nursing care for 1) physiological needs, 2) safety needs, and 3) love & belonging needs, but no significant differences for self esteem needs. ($P < 0.05$)
