The objective of this research is to study the patterns and
factors influencing medical and Paramedical Professionals' participation
in the May event of 1992.

The research indicated that there were correlations between the
May event of 1992 a) attitudes towards the government , group and leaders
of the anti-government organization b) expectation of the success of the
movement c) the supporting of the family members of the protests and
Professional groups d) expectation of the cost and benefits in participating
in the movement and finally e) the influence of mass-communication.

Patterns of participation in the social movement of the sampling
groups varied according to activities and degree of participation in the
social movement of individuals, groups and regional supporters. In addition,
The social movement of the May event was the results of the accumulation
of the dissatisfaction against the government , the political opportunity
structure, ideology and the realization of the collective good and resource
mobilization.

The activities were non-institutionalized political action and
the aim was to see the emergence of the more democratization system.
