

Chollada Taweekoon 2006: Relationship Between Personality and Job Satisfaction of Officers in Rajamangala University of Technology Suvarnabhumi Nonthaburi Campus. Master of Science (Industrial Psychology), Major Field: Industrial Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Mr. Jumrong Ngerndee, M.Ed. 118 pages. ISBN 974-16-2353-4

The purposes of this study were 1) to investigate the level of job satisfaction. 2) to investigate personality of samples 3) to compare their job satisfaction according to five personal characteristics of sex, age, education, position and experience, 4) to compare their job satisfaction according to personality. Samples composed of 186 officers of University. Data were collected by using questionnaire The Maudsley Personality Inventory (MPI), and Satisfaction questionnaire. Data analysis through program for window included percentage, mean, t-test, F-test.

The results are as follows : 1) Majority of the officers have moderate level of job satisfaction. 2) The actual personality of majority officers are classified as extraversion (extraversion-introversion) and stability (neuroticism-stability). 3) There were significant difference in job satisfaction for these of different age, position and experience at level .05 4) There were significant difference in job satisfaction for these of personality type at level .05
