




Slaksna Kittitussaranee 2008: The Relationship between Parenting Styles and Depression of the Forth Level Students in Nonthaburi Education Service Area Office Zone I. Master of Science (Community Psychology), Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Supanee Sontirat, Ed.D. 143 pages.

The objectives of this research were:- 1) to study parenting styles and depression of the Forth Level Students in Nonthaburi Education Service Area Office Zone I:- 2) to examine the relationship between personal factors and depression of the Forth Level Students in Nonthaburi Education Service Area Office Zone I:- 3) to examine the relationship between parenting styles and depression of the Forth Level Students in Nonthaburi Education Service Area Office Zone I.

By multistage random sampling method, 382 samples were drawn from the Forth Level Students in Nonthaburi Education Service Area Office Zone I. Data were obtained by using questionnaires and analyzed by using package computer programs. Statistical procedures were percentage mean standard deviation and Chi-Square. Statistical significance was set at 0.05.

Results revealed that:- 1) Most of parenting styles was authoritative and 17 percents had got depression:- 2) The students' personal factors; family incomes, alcohol used in family, parental relationship and peer group relationship related to students' depression at the 0.05 level of significance:- 3) The parenting styles related to the Forth Level Students' depression at the 0.05 level of significance.
