The objectives of this research were 1) to study level of the quality of work life of the non-commissioned crime suppression police of metropolitan police bureau division 2, and 2) to compare factors affecting the quality of work life of the non-commissioned crime suppression police of metropolitan police bureau division 2. Sampling size was 290 of the non-commissioned crime suppression police officers' of Metropolitan Police Bureau Division 2. Sampling methods were stratified random sampling and simple random sampling. Questionnaire was employed as the tool to collect data. A computer ready-made program was used in analyzing data. Statistics were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, and F-test with the level of significance was set at .05.

The research results found that level of the quality of work life of the non-commissioned crime suppression police of metropolitan police bureau division 2 was moderate. In hypothesis testing, age, marital status, education, salary, work experience and rank did not affect quality of the police officers' work life.
