

Nantawipa Chada 2007: Attitude of Village Public Health Volunteer toward Emergency Medical Service System: Case Study of Sawang Wirawong Sub-district, Ubon Ratchathani Province. Master of Science (Community Psychology), Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Buathong Sawangsopakul, M.S. 145 pages.

The objectives of this research were to study the attitudes of Village Public Health Volunteers toward Emergency Medical Service System as well as to compare the attitude of Village Public Health Volunteers of different personality and personal factor, and study the co-relation between knowledge, receipt of information and attitude toward Emergency Medical Service System.

The population of this research was a group of Village Public Health Volunteers of Sawang Wirawong Sub – district, Ubon Ratchathani Province. Sampling technique was Populational Stratified Random Sampling from 227 staff. Datas were collected by questionnaire. Statistical analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, F-test, LSD and correlation analysis.

The result of study found that the attitudes of the Village Public Health Volunteers of Sawang Wirawong Sub – district, Ubon Ratchathani Province was in high level. Although they were of different genders, ages, education levels and personalities, the study showed no significant difference on the attitude of Emergency Medical Service System. However, the Village Public Health Volunteers who had different income from each other and also different experiences about Emergency Medical Service System and had significant difference on attitude toward the Emergency Medical Service System . This study also found that the knowledge of the Volunteers and the information about Emergency Medical Service System they received had a positive relationship with the attitude toward the Emergency Medical Service System.
