The objectives of this research are to study the general aspects of social capital and the development of quality of life of the people in Koh Kred, Amphoe Pak Kret, Changwat Nonthaburi.

The population under this study consists of 14 community leaders who were members of the Koh Kred Tambon Administration Organization. The qualitative research methods was used in collecting data through the technique of observation, interviewing, and documents reading.

The research findings were as follows: the general aspects of social capital in the Koh Kred were collective gathering, education, culture, honest, social responsibility, communication management and productions in the community. These social capitals had promoted the development of quality of life in 8 dimensions: good health, secure residence, educational obtaining, good family, income received, participation in development, virtuousness and environmental maintenance. It is recommended that people's participation in the preservation and development of the above-mentioned social capital be encouraged so that the quality of life could be securely developed.
