

Arunporn Pitaksa 2010: Factors Related to Participation in Activities of the Aging in Din Daeng Service Center, Bangkok Metropolis. Master of Arts (Applied Sociology), Major Field: Applied Sociology, Department of Sociology and Anthropology.

The objectives of this research were to: 1) study the relationship between personal and family factors and participation in activities of the aging; and 2) to study the satisfaction of the aging in participation in activities of the aging in Din Daeng Service Center. Descriptive survey and cross-sectional study design was applied in this study. Questionnaires were constructed to collect data from study. 231 purposive sample of the aging. Data analysis were made by using the ready-made computer program. The statistics used were average, percentage and comparative study with t-test and F-test. The hypothesis test was established at the statistical level of .05.

The result showed that: 1) Factors significantly related to the elderly's participation in activities were sex, age, pay out, career before aging and satisfied of service. But status, education, income and family relationship were not significantly. 2) The elderly had moderate level of participation in activities and satisfied in the activities at moderate level too.
