

Netnapha Panprung 2010: Factors Relating to Member Voting for Board of Director: A Case Study of Kasetsart University Savings and Credit Co-operative Ltd. Master of Arts (Cooperative Economics), Major Field: Cooperative Economics, Department of Cooperative. Thesis Advisor: Assistant Professor Rangsan Pitipunya, Ph.D. 85 pages.

This research aimed to study the opinion of Kasetsart University Savings and credit cooperative members on the cooperative election system and the factors relating to member voting.

Main data were collected from 433 of the cooperative members. The analysis tools applied in this research were percentage, mean and Chi-square.

It was found that the cooperative members agreed with the present election system of the cooperative. The study also revealed that age, education level, income level, and type of work had significant relation to the members voting.
