

Terawat Kongtong 2006: Factors Related to Violent Crime Against Property of Prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison. The objectives of this research were 1) to study level of violent crime against property of prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison and 2) to study whether the factors of age, education, marital status, occupation, income, expense, dept, broken family, friendliness, drug use and having weapons, were related to violent crime against property of prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison. The selected group for research was 251 prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison sampled by proportional stratified random sampling and simple random sampling. The tool was a questionnaire and information was analyzed through percentage, mean, standard deviation and Chi-square in research summary coefficient at the level of significance .05.

Hypothesis testing of this research showed the following level of violent crime against property of prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison had middle level and research education, expense, broken family, friendliness, drug use and having weapons, were related to violent crime against property of prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison at the level of significance .05. Age, marital status, occupation, income and dept were not related to violent crime against property of prisoners in Bangkok Remand Prison and Klong Prem Central Prison.
