

Kasira Jinaou 2009: Factors Related to Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University. Master of Science (Health Education), Major Field: Health Education, Department of Physical Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Supat Teravecharoenchai, M.Sc. 126 pages.

The purpose of this descriptive research was to study Factors Related to Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University, studied from 380 sample students in South-East Asia University. The questionnaire constructed by the researcher was the tool to collect the data. Data analysis was made by statistical computer package for percentage, mean, standard deviation, Chi-square test, Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient.

The research result was as follows.

1. Health Factors Related to Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University were at the moderate level.
2. The biosocial factors namely salary were associated with Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University at statistical significance level of .05.
3. The predisposing factors namely knowledge, attitude and perception were associated with Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University at a statistical significance level of .01.
4. The enabling factors namely receiving policy in promotion health care of academic institutes and accessing health care center were associated with Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University at statistical significance level of .01.
5. The reinforcing factors namely receiving advice and suggestions from different people including information getting from various sources were associated with Personnel Health Care Behaviors of Students in South-East Asia University at statistical significance level of .01.
