

Seksun Sakulaue 2009: Factors Relating to Food Consumption Behaviors of Napalai Hospital Personnel, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province. Master of Science (Health Education), Major Field: Health Education, Department of Physical Education.

The purpose of this descriptive research was to study factors relating to food consumption behaviors of personnel in Napalai Hospital, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province. The sample of this study were 213 personnel of Napalai Hospital, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province. Data were collected by the questionnaire constructed by the researcher. Data analysis was made by statistical computer package for percentage, mean, standard deviation, Chi-square test, Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient and Stepwise Multiple Regression Analysis.

The research result were as follows.

1. Food consumption behaviors of personnel of Napalai Hospital were at a moderate level.
2. The biosocial factors namely ages and waistline had relat on ship with food consumption behaviors in Napalai Hospital, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province at a statistical significance level of .05
3. The predisposing factors namely knowledge and perception had relat on ship with food consumption behaviors in Napalai Hospital, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province at a statistical significance level of .05
4. The enabling factors namely the convenience of food places and cooking had relat on ship with food consumption behaviors in Napalai Hospital, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province at a statistical significance level of .05
5. The reinforcing factors namely the receiving of information concennig consumption and social support had relat on ship with food consumption behaviors in Napalai Hospital, Bang Khonthi District, Samut Songkhram Province at a statistical significance level of .01
