Abstract

The purpose of this study was to produce an instructional television program on "Cone Painting" for Inventive Art Students Polytechnics School.

The steps were as follows:

- 1. Producing a 40 minutes instructional television program on "Cone Painting".
- 2. Field testing the television program with the art-inventing students at Chiangmai Polytechnic school.
- 2.1 The result was that 11 out of 13 students taking the test could pass it with the percentage of 80 which is the set standard percentage.
- 2.2 Have these students watch the television program and practice cone painting. It was found that 10 out of 11 students (90.91% of the total) could have the average percentage of 91.50.

It can be concluded that this instructional television program on "Cone Painting" for Inventive Art Students Polytecnics School is very effective. It is far above the 90/90 standard criteria.
