## **ABSTRACT**

The purposes of this study were (1) to study The District Khurusapha Committee's opinion, Khurusapha members opinion toward an evaluation of work performance, problems and needs in two aspects: the promotion and teaching profession development as well as teachers security and welfare (2) to compare Khurusapha members opinion on work performance of District Khurusapha committee, taking into account their sexes, experiences and educational attainment.

The sample studied was selected by means of simple random sampling technique and consisted of 106 District Khurusapha committee and 343 Khurusapha members. The instrument for collecting data was a set of questionnaires. The data were analyzed by means of percentage, arithmetic mean, standard deviation, t-test,F-test and Scheffe' multiple on treatment mean

Findings:

District Khurusapha Committee percieved that they
performed their work at the "under average" level. They
percieved that they rarely had problems on work performance.
Khurusapha members also percieved that District Khurusapha
Committee conducted work performanced at the "under average"
level, whereas they needed more services.

The compairison between Khurusapha members opinion with difference in sexes and educational attainment, it was found that their opinions were not different. In case of members with different experiences, it was found that there was statistically significant different opinion at the .05 level and members with more than 26 years of experience have strongly different opinion more than that of other experienced groups.
