

THESIS TITLE : AN EVALUATION OF THE BACHELOR ' S DEGREE PROGRAM

IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION COLLEGES

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ABSTRACT

The objectives of this research were to study the curricula for Bachelor ' s degrees in Education of the Physical Education Colleges . A CIPP Model was used to evaluate the factors related to inputs, processes and production . The 1,132 samples in this research study consisted of 544 administrators and instructors , 486 fourth - year students , and 102 graduate students. Three sets of questionnaires were used for gathering personal data and opinions about the curriculum. The data were analyzed according to basic statistical methods . The results are as follow :

1) Aspect of context , it was found that the objectives of the curriculum are suitable and clearly stated. However, the content in certain areas should be increased . They are mathematics , science and technology.

2) Aspect of basic factors , it was found that in the areas of learning and teaching , the teachers felt that materials used are not at a satisfactory level in both quality and quantity . Graduate students felt that they had enough sports material to use . As for classroom buildings and field work areas, there were sufficient for use.

3) Aspect of process : learning, teaching and evaluation, it was found that teachers should use more educational media . Outside activities need to be improved . The students feel that the measurement and evaluation process should put more emphasis on practical knowledge and ability.

4) Aspect of production , it was found that the majority of graduates have been employed and worked in the private sector. The graduates possess knowledge and ability in training courses and in handling the basic sports. They are able to be the leaders of the sports but they have no confidence to carry on private vocational activities.

5) Certain problems were also found in this study : the curriculum needs high quality text books for services . And also a better coordination between physical education college and joined - teachers' college needs to be improved.
