The objectives of this research were 1) to study the level acceptance of standard farm

2) to study the level of the knowledge of standard farm 3) to compare the acceptance of standard

farm of farmer according to their different demographic backgrounds in terms of gender, age,

experience, education-level 4) to study their personality difference their the effect on acceptance

of standard farm and 5) to study the relations between knowledge of standard farm and acceptance

of standard farm. The samples were 160 farmers. Data were collected by questionnaires and

analyzed by application of program computer. Statistics use were: percentage, mean, standard

deviation, t-test, One Way Anova and Pearson's product moment correlation coefficient.

The results of this research indicated that 1) the level of farmer's acceptance of standard

farm as well as the adoption-level were mostly at the "median-level" 2) the level of farmer's

knowledge of standard farm as well as the adoption-level were mostly at the "high-level"

3) Farmer's with different sex, age, experience, education-level had different in the acceptance of

standard farm at the significant level of .05 4) Farmers with different in personality had no different

of the acceptance of standard farm and 5) there was knowledge of standard farm were related of

the acceptance of standard farm at the significant level of .05
