

JATURONG SANGUTAI : STATE AND PROBLEMS OF THE THAI AMATEUR BOXING
TEAM PREPARATION IN THE TWENTIFIFTH OLYMPIC GAMES. THESIS ADVISOR :

The purpose of this thesis was to study the state and problems of the Thai amateur boxing team preparation in the twentififth Olympic Games as perceived by the three population groups as to the administrators of the Amateur Boxing Association of Thailand and the persons concerned in Thai national amateur boxing team, the Thai national amateur boxing team's coaches and the Thai national amateur boxing team's players. Seventy four questionnaires were sent to the three population groups and sixty nine questionnaires or 93.24 percent were returned. The data were analyzed in terms of percentages, means and standard deviations.

It was found that :

The administrators of the Amateur Boxing Association of Thailand and the persons concerned in Thai amateur boxing team, the Thai national amateur boxing team's coaches and the Thai national amateur boxing team's players had opinions about the state of the Thai amateur boxing team preparation in the twentififth Olympic Games as to the boxers intended to make the reputation for the country, budgeting and welfare for training and competition were sponsored the most by the Amateur Boxing Association of Thailand, there was no any training camp owned by the Amateur Boxing Association of Thailand and there was no any reserved boxers. The opinions about the problems of the Thai amateur boxing team preparation in the twentififth Olympic Games as to budgeting and welfare, and managing the Amateur Boxing Association of Thailand areas were at "more" level but personnel and accommodation, training site and facilities areas were at "less" level.
