The purposes of the research were to study state and problems of conscript students in the project of non-formal educational opportunity expansion in personal affairs, project administration and application, together with comparative study on state and problems of the conscript students in personal affairs, project administration and application among the students in Changwat Lop Buri, Saraburi, and Phra Nakhon Si-Ayutthaya.

The findings indicate that most students are aged between 21 and 23, their domicile is in the country, their occupations are agriculturist and employees. For project administration, most students rarely listen to the lessons from the radio and their teachers teach according to the handbook. For the students' problems, their problems are in the level of having no problems. Their problems are ordered as follows: money problem, educational adjustment, study time, and study curriculum.

The findings of the comparative study on state and problmes of conscript students in personal affairs, project administration and their application among the students in Changwat Lop Buri, Saraburi and Phra Nakorn Si-Ayutthaya also reveal that most students have significant differences in personal affairs at the .01 level; their opinion in project administration and their applications also have significant differences at the .01 level. For the comparative study, most conscript students have no difference in personal problems while most problems in project administration have a significant difference at the .01 level.
