

JARATSRI PROMMAS : STATES AND PROBLEMS OF PROMOTIVE HEALTH
ACTIVITY MANAGEMENT IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL EDUCATION, BANGKOK METROPOLIS.

The purposes of the research were to study the states and problems of promotive health activity management and compare the problems of promotive health activity management in secondary schools under the Jurisdiction of the Department of General Education, Bangkok Metropolis. The 222 questionnaires were distributed to the samples of 74 schools and 210, accounted for 94.6 percent, were returned. The data were analyzed in terms of percentages, means, standard deviations. One-way analysis of Variance and the Sheffe test were applied to determine the significant differences among means.

It was found that :

1. The promotive health activities mostly managed in schools were: managing the school lunch committee in the aspect of promotive activity in nutrition; managing the week of intramural sport competition in the aspect of promotive activity in exercising; managing camping in the aspect of promotive activity in recreation for health; managing religious activities in the aspect of promotive activity in mental health; managing internal traffic system and enforcement in the aspect of promotive activity in safety; and managing exhibition in currently communicable disease control in the aspect of promotive activity in health education.

2. The samples perceived that most problems on the management of school health activities were at the low level except the shortage of budget for purchasing the essential equipments was at the high level.

3. There were no significant differences at .05 level among the perceptions of the head of physical education department, health teachers, and school nurses.
