

CHAIYUT SEREERATH: STATE AND NEEDS OF THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY FOR
PHYSICAL EDUCATION INSTRUCTION. THESIS ADIVSOR: ASSO. PROF.
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The purposes of this research were to study and to compare the needs of Thammasat University students for physical education instruction. Seven hundred and sixty-six questionnaires were sent to Thammasat University students. Seven hundred and sixty-six questionnaires or one hundred percent were returned. The obtained data were analyzed in terms of percentages, means and standard deviations. The t-test and one way analysis of variance was used to determine the level of significant difference. The Scheffe's test was also employed for all possible comparison.

It was found that :

1. The needs of Thammasat University students for physical education instruction, the characteristics of the faculty instructors and the playfield, equipments and facilities areas were at the highest level. The objectives, the methodology, the content and lists of their interests and evaluation of physical education instruction were at the high level.

2. The needs of the Thammasat University students between male students and female students for physical education instruction were significantly different at the .05 level. in the objectives, the methodology, the content and lists of their interests and evaluation of physical education instruction.

3. The needs of Thammasat University students among faculties for physical education instructions were not significantly different at the .05 level.
