Consequently, the wrong attitude composed of high cost standard of living as the result of Amphetamine is popular in the group of truck drivers. It trend to be the cause of accidents increasing each year. The result of studying Penal Sanctions on Amphetamine abused drivers found that the government's measures for solving this problem has two main shortcomings, the first problem concerned with three enforcing laws such as Pyschotropic Substances Act B.E. 2518 which is the general provision concerning the offence of Amphetamine consumption, Land Transportation Act B.E. 2522, and Automobile and Highway Traffic Act B.E. 2522 are the provisions concerned this offence, whoever consumed Amphetamine while driving, the offender will be quilty on another two provisions.
