The purposes of this research were to study the state of actual performance and expectations of management information system in the Office of District Education by using Senn (1978) conceptual framework. A researcher used check list questionnaires to collect data, and a total of 404 copies were sent to population. The 368 usable copies (91.08 percent) were returned. Data were analyzed by frequency distribution and percentage.

The findings of the research are :-

- 1. The Offices of District Education mainly have the objective to collect data, using the forms of district education office. All data are stored, manual processing is carried out, and presentation in the forms of table. The education technicians are responsible for them.
- 2. It is expected by education administrators that : data should be used for decision making, data collection form shouls be made by the Office of District Education, all data should be stored, central data processing should be set up, and presentation in form of charts or pictorial graphs should be used. The education technicians should be assigned to be responsible for them.
