ABSTRACT

The purposes of the research were (1) to determine the operation of the school principals concerning the framework of the education reform, (2) to identify the problems and barriers in carrying on the reform, and (3) to study the opinions of the concerned personnel towards the education reform. The sampling included 27 primary education heads of the districts, 27 district education supervisors and 100 school principals with total of 154 subjects. The developed questionnaire was used for collecting data. The earned data were then analyzed by using SPSS/PC⁺ program for calculating percentages, arithmetic means and standard deviations.

The Results

- 1) There was "much" operation of the education reform in all aspects, especially the reform of the schools and educational institutions and the reform of the curriculum and teaching-learning process.
- 2) There were "moderate" problems and barriers in carrying on the education reform. However, the problems and barriers were "much" in the budget and materials and equipment, while there was "little" problem and barriers in the school surrounding and buildings.
- 3) The district primary education heads, the education supervisors and the school principals had "much" positive attitudes towards the education reform aspects.
