

THESIS TITLE : A STUDY ON THE NEEDS OF THE PRIMARY SCHOOL
BOARDS CONCERNING INSTRUCTIONAL ACTIVITIES IN
THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF
THE OFFICE OF UDONTHANI PRIMARY EDUCATION

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ABSTRACT

The purposes of this investigation were to study needs and suggestions of the primary school boards concerning instruction in the primary schools. The sample was comprised of 125 primary school administrators and teachers and 241 members of the primary school boards. These 366 subjects were randomly selected.

A set of questionnaires was developed to collect data. The earned data were analyzed by a computer program to calculate percentage, arithmetic mean and standard deviation.

The investigation revealed that the primary schools boards highly needed to participate in personnel administration regarding academic work. They properly suggested that the five priority for school instructional management were (1) to conduct instruction emphasizing fundamental knowledge for efficient career, (2) to apply multimedia for instructional activities, (3) to encourage the school boards publicizing the primary school instructional management, (4) to conduct instruction emphasizing life experience and skills, and (5) to manage instructional activities either inside and outside school.
