

Sawika Samat 2011: The Aggressive Behaviors of Students: A Case Study of Female Students with Violent Behaviors. Master of Arts (Social Development), Major Field: Social Development, Interdisciplinary Graduate Program. Thesis Advisor: Major Panomporn Pumjan, Ph.D. 106 pages.

The study of students' aggressive behaviors: case study of female student with violent behaviors aimed to analyze life and factors contributing to aggressive behavior. Main factors are the role of television viewing that effect aggressive behavior by imitating soap opera and the role of parenting by family to students' aggressive behavior.

The study was conducted by qualitative research methods, starting from getting close to the samples and collect data by participant observation and deep interview. Five female students with aggressive behaviors were chosen by snowball technique and collected data by take notes, voice record, and sorting data into categories.

The results showed that in the life of students with aggressive behavior, all samples have shown aggressive and violent behavior since they were children. In most cases, they will have brawl problem in high school until 6 Grad. The results also reveal that students in the sampling group developed their aggressive and violent behavior from many factors. The factors can be sort in order of importance as followed, 1. friends union behavior, mostly night life, drinking alcohol and controversy 2. School, which is the place student changed from polite to aggressive because they were persecute by senior. 3. Family that provide indulgent or sometimes neglect parenting lead children to become self-willed and aggressive. 4. Video clips contains violent, which are favorite among students because it made them feel enjoy and want to behave aggressively.
