


This survey study aimed at identifying caregivers behavior for a care of diarrheal child complying with health promotion approach in Police General Hospital .The study was conducted on 104 caregivers of childhood diarrheal patients admitted in ward of Chalemphrueatmaharachinee forth floor of Police Hospital. The questionnaire being constructed by the researcher was used for data collection. Data analysis was made by computer statistic program for the analysis of the relationship between selected variables and the caregiver's behavior for a care of diarrheal children's relatives by Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient.

The study on the caregiver's behavior for a care of diarrheal child indicated that: The caregiver's behavior for a care of diarrheal child were unsatisfactory. Perceiving concerning a care of diarrheal child had association with the caregiver's behavior for a care of diarrheal child namely perceived severity of diarrhea and perceived benefit of action to advice for a healthcare. The social support for the caregiver resulting to the health of diarrheal child had statistically significant association with the caregiver's behavior for a care of diarrheal child at a statistical significance level of .001.
