
The objective of this study was to develop health promotion integrated model for the overweight students at Jarusornbumrung School. The instrument used for data collection was the questionnaire developed by the researcher.

The sample were consisted of 42 students being selected by purposive sampling. Data analysis was made by computer program for Percentage, Arithmetic Mean, Standard Deviation and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient.

The results of this study showed that the overweight students had statistically significant development in their health promotion behavior at a .05 level. Meanwhile predisposing factor, enabling factor and reinforcing factor had statistically significant relationships with the outcome of health promotion integrated model for the overweight students at a .05 level.
