

Thanittha Chuangmanichot 2011: Leisure Lifestyles of Personnel in Kasetsart University. Master of Science (Recreation), Major Field: Recreation, Department of Physical Education. Thesis Advisor: Assistant Professor Suvimol Tangsujjapoj, Ph.D. 117 pages.

Purposes of this study were to study leisure lifestyles of personnel in Kasetsart University, and relationships among gender, age, the highest education, monthly income and lifestyles of personnel in Kasetsart University. Subjects were selected by simple random sampling, including 127 males (33.69%) and 250 females (66.31%).

The research instrument was a self-administered questionnaire. The content validity was approved by 5 leisure experts. The Index of Congruence was 0.60-1.00 The Alpha coefficient of reliability by using Cronbach method was 0.85. Data were analyzed by using percentage, mean, standard deviation and Chi-square (χ^2).

Findings were found that:- 1) most personnel leisure lifestyles in Kasetsart University were in believers (41.64%), makers (17.51%), strivers (17.24%), achievers (9.02%), experiences (6.92%) and thinkers (3.45%) respectively; and 2) relationships among gender, age, the highest education, monthly income and leisure lifestyles of personnel in Kasetsart University were significant in statistics at .05.
