

Bunchert Somjaipang 2006: State and Problem of Educational Quality Assurance Operation of Basic Education Schools under Suphanburi Educational Service Area Office 2. The purposes of this research were to study state and problem of educational quality assurance operation of basic education schools under Suphanburi Educational Service Area Office 2. The population were 159 schools principals. The instrument used in this research was a questionnaire designed by the researcher. Usable returns of 136 or 85.53 percent were analyzed by means of percentage, mean, and standard deviation.

The results of the research revealed state and problem of educational quality assurance operation of the schools as follows. All three categories of educational quality assurance: 1) student category, 2) administrator category, and 3) teacher category were operated ranging from 64.71 to 91.08 percent. As for the problems of the student category, three standards were found to be at the moderate level while the other four at the low level. The problems of all five standards of the administrator category, and all two standards of the teacher category were found to be at the low level. In addition, the problems of internal educational quality assurance process and external educational quality assessment porcess were also found to be at the low level.
