

Kritsana Buttanu 2009: The Situation and Problems of Business Work Instruction in Work-Oriented Experiences and Technology for Level 3 of Teachers in Secondary Schools under the Office of the Basic Education Commission, Bangkok Metropolitan Area1. Master of Education (Business Education), Major Field: Business Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Shana Wannoon, M.S. 138 pages.

The purpose of the research was to study the situations and problems of Business Work Instruction in Work-Oriented Experiences and Technology for Level 3 of teachers in secondary schools under the Office of the Basic Education Commission, Bangkok Metropolitan Area1. The population of the study was all teachers of level 3 (98 teachers). There was no research sampling. Research instruments were questionnaires. The data analysis had been used by computer program to analyze by using through Frequency, Percentage, Mean, Standard Deviation (S.D.) and Needs Indicator Score (NI).

The results of the current study had been found that the expected and actual situations of Business Work Instruction in teaching preparation, teaching process, and learning evaluation and measurement were high level in all aspects. However, the problems of Business Work Instruction in three aspects were low level or a few problems. Teaching preparation, the problems were the suitable of teaching period for efficiency learning, the additional learning sources in school, the completely of the contents in business works. Teaching process, some problems were the using of teaching tools for students' learning behaviors in their class, the variation of process for subject content introduction, the using of teaching materials that suitable for any subject contents. Learning evaluation and measurement, the problems were the student readiness analysis for subject content improvement, the provident opportunity for students, parents, local people or entrepreneurs in setting some criteria of learning evaluation and measurement.
