The objective of this study was to find out views of police forensic science regional headquarters 2 in respect of factors in the following 3 fields:

1. In the field of results of performance of work, the study was made of the substances of work and the conditions under which work was performed.
2. In regard to the structure of technical units, the study was focussed on administration, scientific crime detection work, criminal record work and work on inspection of scene of incidents.
3. In the field of welfare, the study was conducted of budgetary allocations, buildings and grounds, etc.

In addition, comparative study was made of the characteristics of police officials that influenced views on the above fields, and of relations between views on the structure of technical units and welfare and views on the performance of work.

The results of the study show that police officials were in approval of the structure of technical units. Except for the administration and the results of performance of work and welfare indecision, it should be improved. It was further found in the study that the different characteristics of police officials in respect of sexes, positions, status, academic qualifications and length of service produced different opinions or certain factors on the fields of structure of technical units, results of performance of work and welfare. It was uncovered also that views on the structure of technical units and welfare indicated straight line relations to views on the results of performance of work in respect of every factor.
