The objective of this thesis is to study the policy implementation of Wastes Classification before Disposal project in Latprao district office, the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration. The methodology used was documentary research and field research.

The finding of the study is that Wastes Classification before Disposal project in <u>Latprao</u> district office, the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration is unsuccessful with its purpose and the results are as follow:

1. Wastes Classification before Disposal Project involves public relations which should be a continuel process have a wider coverage.

- 2. In trying to reduce the quantity of wastes there was a compaign of public relations before wastes separation but there was no detailed or specific policy planning. There was no systematic effort to recycle wastes.
- 3. There was not enough resources necessary for project administration namely the budget to purchase garbage touch which and garbage cans which classify wastes.
 - 4. Need and wants of target people are yet to be satisfied.
- 5. Officials in the field possessed ability and good intention in carrying and their works. There were cases of some garbage collectors who separated out quality garbage for their personal gains.
