This research was aimed to study and compare the individual expenditure of the diploma students in vocational education from Rajamangala Institute of Technology Campuses in Bangkok in 1998. The individual expenditure of the students was divided into 7 items including study fees, food, accommodation, transportation, clothes, stationery and others. The comparison of individual expenditure focused on gender, campus, years of study, status of students, hometown, parents' occupation, place to stay, family's financial problem, studying status, scholarship, debt from study fund, sources of fund, expenditure per month, further studying after certificate level, ability to earn, one's living, income per month, This study determined 600 samples. The response rate of returned questionnaires was 100 percent. The statistical values used in this analysis were mean and standard deviation.

Testing the difference from mean, t-test and F-Test were applied by using the statistical significant level of 0.05.

Research results : It was found that the personal expenses of students were different as follows: campus, hometown, parents' occupation, studying status and sources of fund. For other statuses, there were no differences about their expenses.
