The purposes of this research were to analyze the assessment forms for inspecting drinking water manufactures used in 76 provinces in Thailand, to construct the criteria for inspecting drinking water manufactures, to construct the form for inspecting drinking water manufactures and to study food inspectors' opinions toward the propriety of the constructed assessment form for inspecting drinking water manufactures. The sample chosen by purpose were 83 province inspectors from 76 provinces.

The instruments used for gathering data were 1) the assessment form for inspecting drinking water manufactures and it's handout 2) the collecting form about the specialists' opinion and 3) the collecting form about the inspectors' opinion.

The descriptive statistic used to analyze the data: percentage, average etc.

The results of the study were:

1. The collection of the assessment form for inspecting drinking water manufactures in surveillance in public health consumer protection from 76 provinces was 74 papers; that can be grouped in 32 types.
2. The criterion for inspecting drinking water manufactures is 7 specifications and 20 items.
3. The assessment form for inspecting drinking water manufactures in surveillance in public health consumer protection and its handout, which developed consist of checklists.
4. The sample is most of female. The average ages are 33.4 years and the experience is 1.5 years in mode. This sample has much different in ages and experience.
5. The opinion of sample about "the proper weighted score for each checklist" is "1" in the most and "2", "1.5" and "0.5" in sub-order respectively.
