The purposes of this research were to study the personality of drug addicts to find the groups that are at risk in order to plan a preventive programme for them. Samplers are 195 male drug addicts, who have been treated as patients during mental rehabilitation period in Thayarak Hospital. The tool served in the research was 16 PF (Form A)

The results of the research are as follows :

The drug addicts are extremely deviant in factor B (Low Intellinence – High Intelligence)

Strongly deviant are seen in the following factors :

1. Factor G (Expedient and Self indulgent – Conscientious)
2. Factor Q₂ (Group – dependency – Self Sufficiency)
3. Factor C (Emotional instable – Emotional Stable)

Slightly deviant are seen in the following factors :

1. Factor A (Reserved – Outgoing)
2. Factor H (Shyness – Bold and Venturesome)
3. Factor I (Tough Minded – Tender Minded)
4. Factor O (Self – assured – Apprehensive)
5. Factor Q₃ (Undiscipline self conflict – self-respect and controlled)
6. Factor Q₄ (Relaxed – tense)

Average deviant are seen in the following factors :

1. Factor E (Submissive of humble - dominance of ascen dance)
2. Factor F (Sober and Serious – Happy Go Lucky)
3. Factor L (Trusting – Suspiciousness)
4. Factor M (practical – Imaginative)
5. Factor N (Genuine and Forthright –Astute and Shrewd)
6. Factor Q₁ (Conservative – Experimenting and liberal)
