

ABSTRACT

Thesis Title : Satisfaction in Work Performance of Teachers in Vocational Private Schools under the Jurisdiction of the Committee of Private Education, Bangkok Metropolis Administration, Group 4 Thonburi

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Advirosy Committee :

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The purposes of this research were to study satisfaction in work performance of teachers in vocational private schools under the jurisdiction of the Committee of Private Education, Bangkok Metropolitan Administration, Group 4 Thonburi; and to compare level of educational administrators' and teachers' satisfaction in vocational private schools.

The sampling group was composed of 264 teachers in 17 private schools in BMA, Group 4 Thonburi. Teacher' satisfactions were classified into two phases as motivation factor and hygiene factor under Herzberg's theory. Statistical tools utilized for this study were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test and F-test

Research results:

Teachers' satisfaction in work performance under hygiene factor was at the 'moderate' level; for positional promotion or salary increase as the special case was at the 'low' level; and their satisfaction as a whole was at the 'moderate' level; and in the area of technique and modern knowledge in work practice was at the 'high' level which was highly supported and enhance the school's achievement
