The purpose of this quasi experimental research was to study the effects of Group Transactional analysis-group counseling on Adult Ego State of heroine addicts at The Winner House in Bangkok.

The eighteen subjects of heroine addicts were randomly selected who had Adult Ego State scores lower than 12 scores. (Total scores = 25). The Subjects were then randomly assigned to experimental group and control group; each group consisted of 9 heroin dependents. The data was analyzed by the Wilcoxon Matched Pairs Signed-Rank Test and The Mann-Whitney U Test.

The results were as follows :

Two hypothesis were tested in the data analysis. It was found that one out of two of the hypothesis was statistically significance.

The study indicated that the Adult Ego state of the experimental group was statistically significant higher than before the experiment at .01 level.

The study was no significant difference of Adult Ego state between the experimental group and the control group.
