

## ABSTRACT

This Title : A Study of Relationship between Factors Influencing  
to Career Maturity of Mathayomsuksa 3 Students in  
Suphanburi Province.

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The objective of this research is to study the relationship between factors influencing to career maturity of the Mathayomsuksa 3 students in Suphanburi Province.

The sample used in this research are 450 Mathayomsuksa 3 th students from the government and the private schools who are studying in the academic year of 1999. The tool used in this study is the Career Maturity Inventory by John O Crites which translated by Assoc.Prof.Dr.Parnarai Sapayaprapa.

The Result are as follow :

1. There were 64 % of students in Mathayomsuksa 3 th from Suphanburi Province intended to study in the general education field, 34.2 % in the vocational field where 1.8 % did not want to further their studying.

2. Resulting from the study of 8 factors, which are gender, father's occupation, mother's occupation, father and mother's highest education, the way of raising, student's grade point average and parent's income, it is found that gender, mother's occupation, mother's highest education, student's grade point average and parent's income are related significantly to student's career maturity at the level of .05.

3. It is found that the correlation coefficient between the student's career maturity and the student's grade point average, mother's highest education, gender, mother's occupation and the parent's income are at .262, .197, .181, .162, .139 respectively.

4. The students' career maturity from the government schools are higher significantly than from the private schools at the level of .05.
