The present research studied the limitations of the environmental pollution monitoring system which is currently in use in Thailand according to the Thai legal system and simultaneous studied the environmental auditing system which has been widely used for a long time in many industrialized countries and which may serve guideline for improving the efficiency of the environmental pollution monitoring system of Thailand.

It was found that the environmental pollution monitoring system of Thailand has three major limitations 1) lack of recording and filing of documents systematically 2) lack of investigation and verification of data and documents and 3) lack of reporting environmental information to the public. These limitations reveal that the environmental pollution monitoring system of Thailand is not up to international standards. Therefore it is recommended that the environmental auditing system be adopted to improve the efficiency of the environmental pollution monitoring system of Thailand.
