

## ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were two fold : (1) to study the problems of the first Thailand University Football league and (2) to compare the opinions of the organizing committee, team managers or coaches, and athletes concerning the problems in conducting and organizing the first Thailand University league.

Questionnaires were used to collect data from 410 persons. Out of 186 questionnaires and 184 were returned that accounted for 98.92 percent. The data were analyzed by the percentage, mean, standard deviation and one-way deviation analysis of variance in SPSS/PC<sup>+</sup>. ( <sup>+</sup> (Statistical Package for the Social Sciences/ Personal Computer Plus)

1. The problems of all aspects the were as follow :
  - 1.1 There was not much problem in the objectives.
  - 1.2 There was not enough budget for the operation.

1.3 The problems of organizing and conduction were the requirements of athlete's qualification, the change or delay of the competition, and the operation of the organizing committee.

1.4 The were insufficient parking lot, training field, dressing room and bathroom.

1.5 The cheering teams, composed mostly of students, were unable to participate fully due to the their classes or the examinations.

1.6 There was a lillle problem in the welcoming ceremony.

1.7 The referees mostly lacked justice.

1.8 There was not much problem as far as security is concerned.

1.9 The nursing was mostly sufficient.

1.10 The information was quite adequate.

1.11 The protest manners were mostly acceptable.

1.12 The rewards were erlatively just.

In camparing of all aspects in organizing and conducting the first Thailand University Football League, there were not significant difference in the opinions among organizing committees, team managers or coachas, and athletes. at 0.05 level. the objectives and the budget for organizing and conducting.
