This research has studied from the 56 registered non-life insurance companies operate in Thailand. All the information analyzed herein were collected from documents related to insurance business and also by interviewing people who worked or involed in the insurance business and results found by this research were:

- 1. The financial ratio of many non life insurance companies under The Non Life Insurance Act B.E. 2535 were below standard as set by The Non Life Insurance Act B.E. 2535. It means that these companies have internal problems of instability and growth.
  - 2. The problems of these companies were not caused by the requirement of The Non Life Insurance Act B.E. 2535, but it was rather caused from the companies'

policy implementation, i.e. unreadyness and internal management problem of the companies and weak supervision and control from the Department of Insurance, Minister of commerce.
