

Sermsook Thippayamart 2011: Survey of Current Situations and Problems Concerning the Operation of Classroom Research at Santirat Institute of Business Administration. Master of Education (Business Education), Major Field: Business Education, Department of Vocational Education. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Vikorn Tantawutho, Ed.D. 126 pages.

The purpose of the research was to identify the current situation and problem concerning the operation of classroom research at Santirat Institute of Business Administration. The population consisted of 70 teachers at Santirat Institute of Business Administration. The questionnaire was used to collect data. Useable questionnaire of 70 copies, or 100 percent were returned. Data were analyzed in terms of percentage.

The results indicated that all instructors conducted classroom researches. The classroom researches were proceeded in four steps as follows: 1) Planning step used : teachers identified research problems by observing and recording the behaviors of students in the classroom. 2) Acting step: teachers performed according to the plans 3) Observing step: teachers collected data from students. 4) Results reflecting and improving step: teachers reflected the results directed to behaviors of the students and also discussed the result with other teachers. Majority of teachers wrote the reports in informal form. For problems of conducting classroom researches, majority of problem was at the moderate level except lacking of knowledge on classroom research, heavy teaching load and not have available time. Which were considered at the high level and affected more than forty percents of teachers.
