

Raweenan Ruenprot 2009: Influence Personal Factors, Resilience and Perfectionism on Adaptation of Students at Phranakhon Rajabhat University. Master of Science (Community Psychology), Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Mr. Theerapat Wongkumsin, Ed.D. 174 pages.

The objectives of this research were to study: 1) the level of the adaptation of students at Phranakhon Rajabhat university, 2) the level of the resilience of students at Phranakhon Rajabhat university, 3) the level of the perfectionism of students at Phranakhon Rajabhat university, 4) personal factors, resilience and perfectionism that influence on adaptation of students of Phranakhon Rajabhat university. The samples used in this research were 1,002 students of Phranakhon Rajabhat university. The data were collected by questionnaires and analyzed by a statistical package program. The statistical methods used for analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation, and multiple regression analysis using the enter method technique.

The results were as follows: 1) the adaptation of students were at the medium level, 2) the resilience of students were at the high level, 3) the perfectionism of students were at the medium level, and 4) the analysis of enter multiple regression analysis found that mutual 32 variables could predict the adaptation of students with the statistical significance level of .001 and could explain it at 35.0 percent ( $R^2 = 0.350$ ), that resilience and perfectionism could predict the adaptation with the statistical significance level of .001 and personal factors such as; sex, grade point average, group of faculty(college of education) and mother's occupation(freelance) could predict the adaptation with the statistical significance level of .05.
