## ABSTRACT

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The purposes of this research were to study and compare the desirable characteristics of a headcoach for the volleyball team as perceived by administrators, coaches and athletes. A questionnaire designed by the researcher was used to collect the data from a sample of 19 administrators, 14 coaches and 84 athletes. All of the 117 questionnaires (100%) were completed and returned. These data so obtained were analyzed by SPSS/PC+ using percentage, mean, standard deviation and one-way analysis of Variance together with Scheme's method at the .05 level of significance

The results were as follows:

1) The opinions of the administrators, coaches and athletes concurring the desired characteristics of the volleyball head coach in all five aspects, were at a high level.

2) In general no statistically significant difference was found among the administrators, coaches and athletes in Thais opinions concerning the desirable

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characteristics of the volleyball training, except, on the sports science whereby significant difference was found between the administrators and coaches and between the coaches and athletes

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
