The purposes of this research were twofold—to study the ethical behaviors of vocational certificate students at Kanchanaburi Vocational College in the aspects of discipline, honesty, responsibility, sacrifice, self-reliance and diligence, and to compare the ethical behaviors of vocational certificate students at Kanchanaburi Vocational College in relation to their sexes and ages.

The research findings were as follows :

1. All aspects of the ethical behaviors studied of the students were at high level.
2. The comparison of the students' ethical behaviors indicated that there was no significant difference in all aspects of the ethical behaviors between male and female students, but there was at .05 level in the aspects of honesty, responsibility and self-reliance. No significant difference was found in the rest of the behaviors.
