At present, there are many unskilled illegal alien labors from neighbor countries i.e. Myanmar, Laos and Cambodia, work in Thailand. These people have left their homelands due to the political and economical situation. They are looking for jobs in order to remit money back home to their families. Nevertheless, they have not only violated Thai law but also caused many problems to Thai Society.

The research shows that these unskilled illegal labors have caused so many problems such as safety in life and property, crime, overcrowded population, Thai's jobs, and increase burden to public welfares. Though Thai Government, by The Minister Committee's resolutions, has resolved in 1992 and 2001 to allow such alien labors to work in definite conditions and waiting to push back. It seems that the Government no seriously resolved the problems and ineffectively enforce the laws. This thesis proposes to amend the Alien Working Act B.E. 2521 and the Immigration Act B.E. 2522 in parts of employer or undertaker and alien labors and also proposes more effective measurements to control and push back such unskilled labors.
