The objectives of this research are threefold; firstly, to evaluate the effectiveness of Training and Semeniar Course for High Level Governing Officers on increaseing knowledge of the 39 th; secondly, to evaluate the worth of Training and Semenar Course for High Level Governing Officers; thirdly, to study the problems of project implementation during the 2 nd August to the 29 th October 1999 at School for High level Government Officers, Thanyaburi District, Pathumtani Province.

The research findings are as follows:

- 1. This project is effective in increasing knowledge of the trainees.
- 2 subjects are most effective and 48 subjects are less than the two.
 - 2. The course is worthy and useful for the trainees.
- 3. The trainees suggest that training on 10 subjects should be cancelled, especially on Research Methodology, but training on 26 subjects should be added, especially on subjects related to economics. Furthermore, modern technological courses, seminar courses and field studies in private sectors are suggested to be added in this project. In addition, power in decision-making on budgetary and personnel administration should be decentralized to the project administrators.
